The Fast of Tammuz commemorates the breach of the city walls of Jerusalem This Tuesday, July 11 marks the Fast of Tammuz which commemorates the breach of the city walls of Jerusalem, as well as the destruction of the first tablets of the ten commandments following the sin of the golden calf. Fast begins at 3:49 am, morning services begin at 7:15 am, Minhah begins at 7:30 pm (men wear tefillin) and the fast ends at 8:56 pm.

Tisha B'Ab, commemorates the destruction of both the First and Second Temples in ancient Jerusalem as well as other historic tragedies that have befallen the Jewish people. At Shearith Israel, we have a number of unique customs for Tisha B'Ab: The Reader's Desk and Holy Ark are draped in black, the evening and morning services are conducted from a special table-also draped in black-rather than from the Reader's Desk, the synagogue lights are dimmed, and the congregants follow services with small flashlights. The melodies of Tisha B'Ab are somber and deeply moving. Join our Shamash, Z. Edinger, on Wednesday night July 26 as he teaches about these and other S&P customs to expect on Tisha B'ab.
