**First Year's Dues:** Since our membership year starts in July, members who join from January through June can pay 50% of the full year's rate. Those who join from July through December are kindly asked to pay the full rate. Remember, membership dues are treated as a fully deductible donation.

\* Burial right does not include interment fee, which must be paid in full in advance of burial.

\*\* Elector Eligibility- In summary, eligible members may be nominated to become electors after four years in good standing and paying the "required seat rental" as per the Shearith Israel Constitution/Bylaws. Elector privileges are maintained by continuing to meet all eligibility requirements. Once lost, eligibility renews after satisfying the requirements for initial eligibility.

NOTE: Individuals who wish to be members of Shearith Israel but who cannot afford the membership dues are invited to speak with the Executive Director. The Congregation welcomes those who sincerely wish to be members, and makes allowances for those who are unable to afford the full rates.
